Eligibility Criteria for the grants

In order to apply for the home care grants assistance, the individual must meet the following criteria:

- Monmouth County resident
- Age 60 years or older or 18 years or older with a chronic physical or mental disability
- NOT have a paid live-in caregiver
- NOT eligible for Medicaid

The grants can provide temporary assistance while the individual is awaiting approval of Medicaid or other long-term assistance.

Preference is given to those individuals with the greatest physical, social, emotional and economic need in accordance with the Older American's Act.



What do the grants provide?

- Certified home health and supportive care services.
- Assistance with activities of daily living such as bathing, dressing, meal preparation, grocery shopping and laundry.
- Relief to caregivers who assist an elderly or disabled relative or friend.
